Sun City Photography Club where he has won two Best of Shows in their annual competitions, the Williamson County Art Guild, Round Rock Arts Alliance, the Georgetown Art Center, and the Texas Photographic Society His photos have appeared numerous times as covers of the "Sun Rays" magazine. He has belonged to six photographic organizations, five in Texas. He is a founder of the Art Attack,
